CREMATION AUTHORIZATION

Upon my oath, and under penalty of law, I hereby affirm that to the best of my knowledge there is no other person having the prior right to give authorization under Oregon Revised Statutes 97.130 (see below), and to control the remains of the above named decedent except _____ who has given me written or facsimile instructions to sign the foregoing authority, the original copy of which I herewith file with the Crematorium.

OREGON REVISED STATUTES ORS • 97.130 (abbreviated)

- (1) Any individual of sound mind who is 18 years of age or older, by completion of a written signed instrument or by preparing or prearranging with any funeral service practitioner licensed under ORS chapter 692, may direct any lawful manner of disposition of the individual's remains. Except as provided under subsection (6) of this section, disposition directions or disposition prearrangements that are prepaid or that are filed with a funeral service practitioner licensed under ORS chapter 692 shall not be subject to cancellation or substantial revision.
- (2) A person within the first applicable listed class among the following listed classes that is available at the time of death or, in the absence of actual notice of a contrary direction by the decedent as described under subsection (1) of this section or actual notice of opposition by completion of a written instrument by a majority of the members or the eldest willing and able member of a prior class, may direct any lawful manner of disposition of a decedent's remains by completion of a written instrument:
 - i) spouse of the decedent;
 - ii) a son or daughter of the decedent 18 years of age or older;
 - iii) either parent of the decedent;
 - iv) a brother or sister of the decedent 18 years of age or older;
 - v) a guardian of the decedent at the time of the death;
 - vi) a person in the next degree of kindred to the decedent;
 - vii) the personal representative of the estate of the decedent;
 - viii) the person nominated as the personal representative of the decedent in the decedent's last will;
 - ix) a public health officer.
- (3) The decedent or any person authorized in subsection (2) of this section to direct the manner of disposition of the decedent's remains may delegate such authority to any person 18 years of age or older. The person to whom the authority is delegated shall have the same authority under subsection (2) of this section as the person delegating the authority.
- (6) If the decedent directs a disposition under subsection (1) of this section and those financially responsible for the disposition are without sufficient funds to pay for such disposition or the estate of the decedent has insufficient funds to pay for the disposition, or if the direction is unlawful, the direction shall be void and disposition shall be in accordance with the direction provided by those persons given priority in subsection (2) of this section and who agree to be financially responsible.

CREMATION DISCLOSURE

The following information concerning the cremation process is provided by Macy and Son Crematory. This service is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The body presented to Macy and Son Crematory is that of the named deceased.
2. Certain HEART PACEMAKERS or any other MEDICAL DEVICES subjected to the intense heat of a crematory could explode. The signatory to this cremation authorization assumes total responsibility for damages or injury sustained to persons or facilities resulting from said explosion.
3. For sanitation purposes it is the policy of Macy and Son Crematory that the body be enclosed in a container.
4. All prostheses (hip joints, surgical pins, etc.) will be discarded after the cremation process is completed. GOLD inlays and fillings, RINGS and other JEWELRY will lose their identity and will also be discarded.
5. The bulk of the cremated remains will be returned, however some will be lost during the process of containerization.
6. Final processing is the pulverization of cremated remains to an unidentifiable dimension.
7. The cremated remains will be returned in a corrugated or plastic box, unless otherwise specified.
